Lindita Hoxha, born in Albania, started to study violin at the age of 6 at "Jordan Misja Lyceum" in Tirana. She has been studying with Robert Papavrami for 10 years. Later she graduated from the Folkwang Hochschule für Musik in Essen where she also got full honours soloist diploma under the guidance of Vesselin Paraschkevov (former concertmaster of Wiener Philharmoniker). In 2002 she graduated from "S. Cecilia" Academy in Rome with Bice Antonioni. She has attended master classes held by: Viktor Tretyakov, Valery Gradov, Ida Händel, Ruggiero Ricci, Alexandre Dubach, Dénes Zsigmondy, Jean-Pierre Wallez and Vladimir Mendelssohn. Top prize winner at many national and international competitions, she often serves as judge for international competitions and holds courses as well. In July 2014 she performed Vivaldi's "The Four Seasons" at "Bilkent University Concert Hall", at the opening concert of the Italian Presidency of the Council of the European Union organized by the Embassy of Italy in Turkey.
